Dr Nicole Panizza is an internationally acclaimed collaborative pianist, scholar, educator, and arts consultant. A Fulbright Award recipient - and Harvard University, University of Oxford, and Manhattan School of Music visiting research fellow - she completed her Doctoral studies with Roger Vignoles at the <u>Royal College of Music</u>. She has since gained international renown for inter-medial research that creatively explores cultural memory, embodied ethnographies, and the text-music partnership as historical source.

Nicole has worked for Opera Australia, the Cologne and Covent Garden Opera Awards, and as Education Manager for The Royal Opera, Covent Garden. She has presented key lectures and seminars in Singapore, Oxford, Sydney, Vancouver, Paris, Aveiro, Florence, Kyoto, Sydney, Adelaide, and Cambridge, and recitals in London, Boston, New York, Oxford, Rome, Dublin, Graz, Bonn, Amherst, and Philadelphia. Artistic and academic affiliations include ENO; Oxford Literary Festival; ROH; Snape Maltings; University of Oxford; The International Center for American Music; Università degli Studi di Firenze; Oxford Lieder Festival; St James Piccadilly; BBC; The University of Adelaide, and The Orpheus Instituut.

Recent research includes the award-nominated albums *Nature* with soprano Jane Sheldon, and *Emergence-Emily Dickinson* with soprano Nadine Benjamin; an inter-medial performance project based on Emily Dickinson's fragment manuscripts in collaboration with Dr. Sally Bayley, Prof. Suzie Hanna, and Dr Hannah Sanders, and *Lo squardo poetico americano*: a practice-based investigation of 20th-century American poetry and art song in partnership with the International Center for American Music, and Lyceum Club Internazionale Firenze. Publications include *A Performer's Encounter with Emily Dickinson: Reading in the Dark* (Routledge, 2023), *The Language of Emily Dickinson* (Vernon Press, 2021), a book chapter for Cambridge Scholars Press, articles for the EDIS Journal, and various blog essays for the Women's Song Forum.

Current research includes a study of renowned conductor/composers Giacomo, Achille, and Ettore Panizza in collaboration with La Scala, the Royal Opera Covent Garden, The Metropolitan Opera, and Teatro Colón; an inter-medial study of John Ruskin's relationship to music in association with The Ruskin, Brantwood, and the Ruskin School of Art; an intermedial project in collaboration with UK artist-writer Zsuzsanna Ardó based on contemporary readings of Francesca Caccini's 1624 opera *La liberazione di Ruggiero*, and *Performing Emily Dickinson* - an international digital platform showcasing practice-based 'readings' of Emily Dickinson's literary canon.

Nicole currently holds the positions of Assistant Professor (Music), <u>Coventry University</u>; Artistic Director, *The Panizza Dynasty Project*, and *Performing Emily Dickinson*; Creative Advisor, <u>The International Center for American Music</u> (ICAMus), and Creative Curator, <u>Women's Song Forum</u>.
